IN THAT THE DEFENDANT DID: intentionally cause physical injury by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument; with intent to cause physical injury to a person who is sixty-five years of age or older, he or she causes such injury to such person, and the actor is more than ten years younger than such person; cause physical injury by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument, acting with criminal negligence and with intent to harass, annoy or alarm another person struck, shoved, kicked or otherwise subjected such other person to physical contact, or attempted or threatened to do the same.

THE GROUNDS FOR THE DEPONENT'S BELIEF ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Deponent states, based upon official investigation, defendant's statements, video surveillance, and witnesses known to the deponent, that, at the above time and place, inside of a MTA train, the defendant kicked a witness known to the deponent, multiple times about the head, neck, and chest, while wearing boots. Deponent further states based upon official investigation, defendant's statements, video surveillance, and witnesses known to the deponent, as a result of the defendant's aforementioned conduct, the witness suffered substantial pain, a laceration above her left eye, difficulty opening her left eye, and bruising and redness about her face and head.

Deponent further states based upon official investigation, defendant's statements, video surveillance, and witnesses known to the deponent that as a result the witness was treated at a local hospital.

Deponent further states based upon official investigation, defendant's statements, video surveillance, and witnesses known to the deponent, that defendant's aforementioned conduct caused the witness to experience annoyance, alarm, and fear for the witnesses physical safety.
