PO MARIO FRANCO of TD SOU, Shield# 3483, states that on or about October 8, 2015 at approximately 4:35 PM at North east corner of Jerome Avenue & East Fordham Road, County of the Bronx, State of New York,

THE DEFENDANT COMMITTED THE OFFENSES OF:

- 1 (F) P.L. 110/170.10(4) Attempted Forgery 2^ DQO
- 2 (F) P.L. 110/170.25 Attempted Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument 2^ DQO
- 3 (M) P.L. 170.20 Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument 3^ DQO

IN THAT THE DEFENDANT DID: attempt to with intent to defraud, deceive or injure another, falsely make, complete or alter a written instrument which was or purported to be or which was calculated to become or represent if completed, part of an issue of tokens, public transportation transfers, certificates or other articles manufactured and designed for use as symbols of value usable in place of money for the purchase of property or services; attempt to with the knowledge that it was forged and with intent to defraud, deceive or injure another, utter or possess a forged instrument of a kind specified in P.L. 170.10 and with the knowledge that it was forged and with intent to defraud, deceive or injure another, utter or possess a forged instrument.

THE GROUNDS FOR THE DEPONENT'S BELIEF ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Deponent states that at the above time and place, a subway station on the #4 subway line, he observed defendant standing in front of a subway turnstile. Deponent further states that he observed defendant bend two (2) Metrocards and swipe each card through the turnstile. Deponent further states that he observed defendant attempt to swipe each Metrocard through the turnstile approximately 10 - 12 times in an attempt to gain entry to the subway platform.

Deponent further states that the transit authority Metrocard bares an electronic bar code that is read by the computerized turnstile system to determine if sufficient fare is on the card and to allow the user of said card access to the subway system.

Deponent further states that he is a New York City Police Officer and as



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such is the lawful custodian of said subway system and the defendant did not have permission or authority to attempt to gain access into the New York City subway system without paying the required fare.

IN THAT THE DEFENDANT DID: with intent to obtain public transportation service without payment of the lawful charge therefor, obtain or attempt to obtain such service or avoid or attempt to avoid payment therefor by force, intimidation, stealth, deception, or mechanical tampering, or by unjustifiable failure or refusal to pay and knowingly enter or remain unlawfully in a building or upon real property which was fenced or otherwise enclosed in a manner designed to exclude intruders.

THE GROUNDS FOR THE DEPONENT'S BELIEF ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Deponent states, upon information and belief, the source of which is the supporting deposition being filed with this instrument by PO CHARLES HALL Shield# 8385 of the TD/CITF states that on or about 03/04/2015 at approximately 21:26 at Bainbridge Avenue and Jerome Avenue 4 Line in Bronx County, State of New York.

Informant observed the defendant enter the subway station beyond the turnstile, which is an area enclosed by the turnstile and gates in a manner designed to exclude those who do not pay the required fare, without permission or authority to do so and without paying the required fare, by pulling the wheel of a turnstile backwards and slipping through.

Deponent is further informed that informant is a New York City Police Officer and as such is the lawful custodian of the New York City Transit



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Authority subway system and the defendant did not have permission or authority to enter the subway system at the above location without paying the required fare.
